- Players must be at least 18 years old
- Not USA Hockey Sanctioned event / however USA hockey rules apply.
- No substitutions or borrowing of players!! This will be strictly enforced.
- Both divisions are no check,
- Below waste slap shots allowed in B division
- Each team will play minimum of three games / plus playoffs
- Games will consist of three 17 minute periods, plus four minute warmup / 1 minute period breaks / each team has a one minute time out per game.
- Three goal limit per player, per game.
- Three penalties in one game will result in ejection.
- Fighting will result in ejection of game !! tournament ?

- Level 4 High School hockey / substantial hockey abilities, skills, knowledge and experience. Played a considerable amount of hockey in the past.
- Level 3 Never played organized but damn good / great wide middle of adult recreational hockey. Have good knowledge of the game, skating and puck handling skills and can play at a general competitive level.
